**Sub - Establishment of NILM University, Katthal (Haryana) as a Private University**


Sir,  
 With reference to State Government Notification No. No. Leg. 21/2011 dated 27.09.2011 on the above subject, I am directed to say that NILM University, Katthal (Haryana) has been established by an Act (No. 16 of 2011) The Haryana Private Universities (Amendment) Act, 2011 (No. 32 of 2006) of State Legislature of Haryana as a State Private University and is empowered to award degrees as specified by the UGC under section 22 of the UGC Act 1956 through its main campus with the approval of statutory bodies / councils, wherever required.

As per the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Prof. Vaishali Vs State of Chhattisgarh there is no provision to have Regional Centres/ Off Campus beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State.

Keeping in view of the above, you are requested to adhere on the following:-

- No off campus centre(s) is opened by the University under the territorial jurisdiction of the State in view of the judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Vaishali Vs State of Chhattisgarh.
- In case the University has already started any off campus centre outside the State it must be closed immediately. It may also be ensured that any off campus centre within the State shall be opened only as per the provision laid down in the UGC (Establishment and maintenance of standards in Private University) Regulation 2003 and with the prior approval of UGC.
- The University shall not have any affiliated Colleges.
- The University has to follow UGC (Minimum standards and procedure for award of M Phil / Ph.D degree) Regulation, 2009.

The University is required to follow the UGC (Establishment and Maintenance of standards in Private University) Regulation 2003 (entry conditions & other Regulations issued from time to time and posted on UGC website [www.ugc.ac.in](http://www.ugc.ac.in))

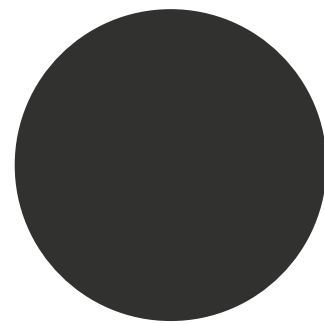

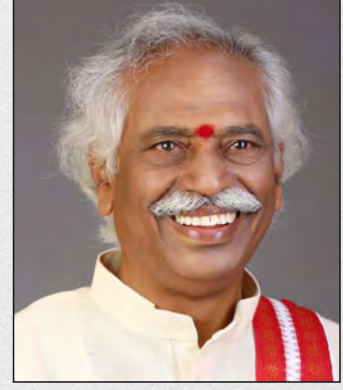



## LAND OF HISTORICAL PANORAMA

Kaithal was part of the Karnla District at the time of Haryana State formation. Later Kaithal became the part of the Kurukshetra District. On November 01, 1989, it became the headquarter of the Kaithal District of Haryana. Kaithal has only three and half hours drive from the National Capital.

It is located near the Bidkian Lake, and was an important town during Akbar's rule. The town is said to have been founded by Yudhishtira in celebration of the Pandavas' victory in the Mahabharata. It was first known as Kapisthala, or Abode of Monkeys, and is the birth place of the monkeys' God 'Hanuman'. A temple in memory of Hanuman's mother 'Anjana', is built here.

Kaithal has many colleges and schools which are imparting world class education to the students of Kaithal District area. The NIILM Education Trust has established the NIILM University in Kaithal. This is a major landmark in the education sector of the Kaithal District. The international feel, well developed infrastructure and the quality of education, all contribute to the academic excellence of the University. It is believed that in the coming years the University will contribute in a big way to the growth and development of not only Kaithal, but the entire state. At present, Kaithal is a flourishing town known for its cotton and rice plantation. All modern facilities and amenities are available in the city. # HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

## THE SITE OF BATTLE BETWEEN RAJIA SULTAN AND DELHI FORCES

A fierce battle between Razia Sultan (Iltutmish's Successor) and the rebel forces of Delhi, was fought here. She is said to be buried here, although her tomb is also a mosque near her tomb. The Emperor Akbar renovated this town and built a fort, and after the third battle of Panipat the region came under the rule of Bhai Desu Singh, a Sikh leader, whose palace has now no been converted into a police station and overlooks the lake.

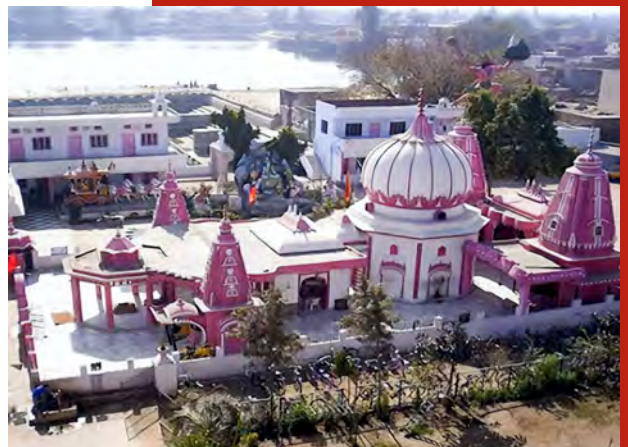
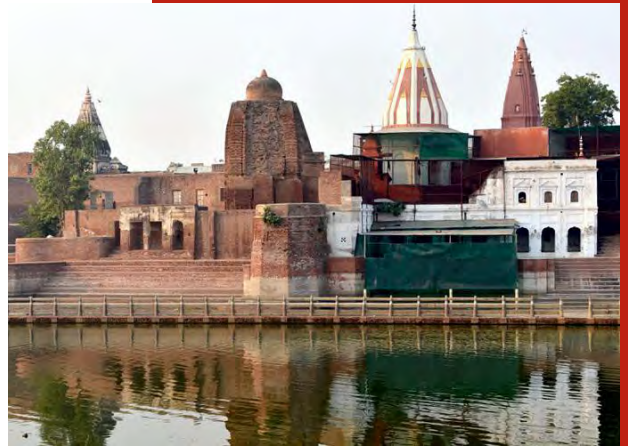
## THE MAIN ATTRACTIONS

The Phelgu tank is a watery and holy site in honour of Rishi Phelgu who meditated here, and the Pundri tank dates back to the Mahabharata period. A few temples are also scattered around, like the Saraswati temple, Kapil Muni Temples and Baba Narayan Das temple. The tombs of Shah Wilayat, Sheik Shihabuddin, Shah Kamal and Bidkiyar Kale itself are worth a look.

## BRICK TEMPLES

Going to legend, a king called Shalivahana ruled area is the 7th century AD. He was cursed that he would die during the night, but by a stroke of luck he touched the earth where the temple now stands. The curse was revoked, and the King's happiness knew no boundaries. So he gave orders for five temples to be built, out of which only two stand now.

One of them must have originally stood on a terrace but is now half buried under a mound of earth. Both temples follow the Ajanta-Ellora pattern of rock cut facade. Constructed from carved bricks, the highest point culminated in a shikara (pinnacle) and is joined in a beehive manner.

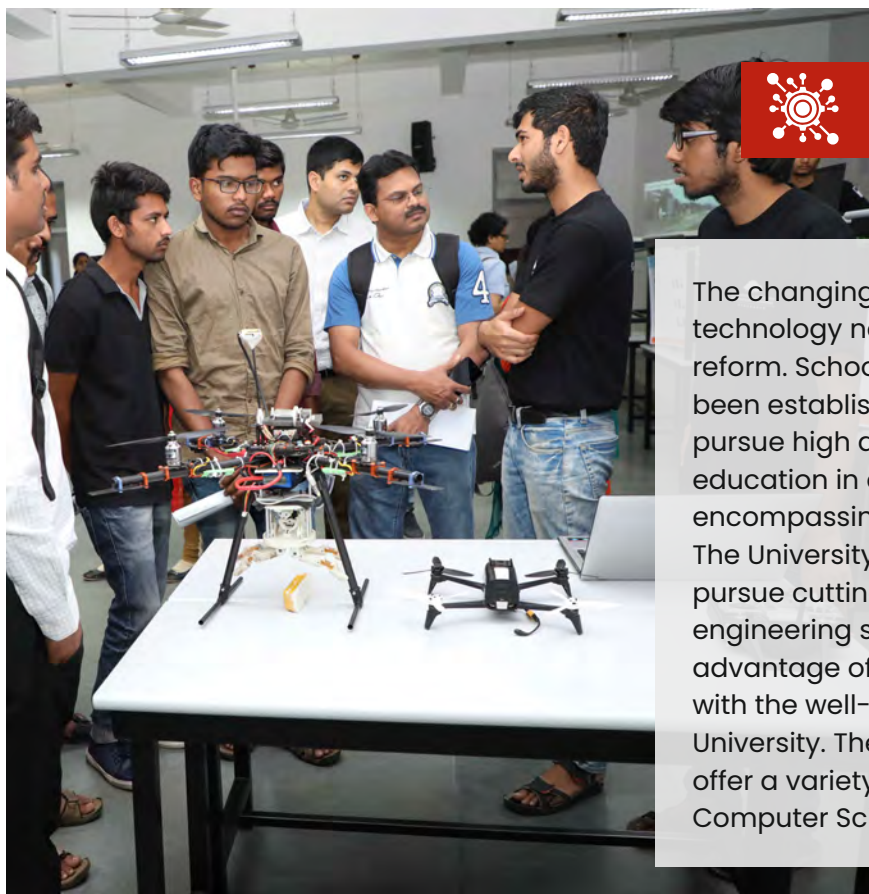
# SCHOOL OF COMPUTER SCIENCE

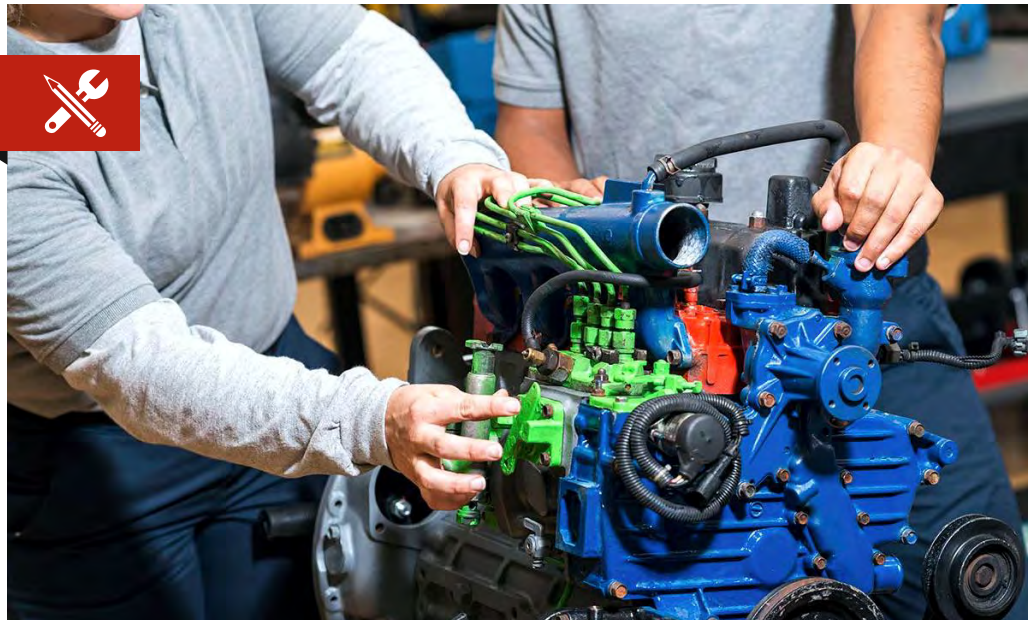

# UG CURRICULUM AND CREDIT FRAMEWORK: HIGHLIGHTS

The University follows the Scheme of Studies as per Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), and NEP 2020 is adopted from the academic session 2023–24. NEP 2020 advocates that a holistic and multidisciplinary education would aim to develop all capacities of human beings –intellectual, aesthetic, social, physical, emotional, and moral in an integrated manner. Such a holistic education approach is necessarily required at the undergraduate level. The 4-year multidisciplinary Bachelor's programme, however, shall be the preferred option since it allows the opportunity to experience the full range of holistic and multidisciplinary education in addition to a focus on the chosen major and minors as per the choices of the student. It includes the following features:

- Opportunity for learners to choose the courses of their interest in all disciplines
- Provision of multiple entry and exit options with a UG Certificate or UG Diploma or UG Degree depending on the number of credits earned
- Flexibility for students to move among the institutions through the implementation of Academic Bank of Credits (ABC)
- Flexibility to switch to alternative modes of learning (Offline, ODL, Online, and Hybrid modes)
- Enriched curricular framework for holistic development of graduate

Each discipline offers multiple categories of courses. As per NEP 2020, students have flexibility to choose the courses from the pool of courses.

**Discipline Specific Core (DSC):** It is a mandatory core credit course of study to be taught in a programme. For example, in B.A. (Honours) History, the DSC shall be the core course of History. In multidisciplinary courses of study, such as B.Sc. (Honours) Life Sciences programme, a student shall study credit courses of three disciplines i.e., Botany, Zoology and Chemistry.

**Minor Courses (MIC):** It is a pool of credit courses of that particular discipline for a single discipline programme of study, for a multidisciplinary programme of study. A student may choose a course of study from this pool of courses. It includes vocational courses also.

**Multidisciplinary Courses (MDC):** It is a pool of courses which is meant to provide multidisciplinary or interdisciplinary education to students, excluding the courses offered by the parent discipline. In case a student opts for DSEs beyond his/her discipline specific course(s) of study, such DSEs shall be treated as MDCs for that student.

**Ability Enhancement course (AEC), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) & Value Addition Course (VAC)**

Students are advised to coordinate with their departments for the detailed programs, assessment and examination framework.

**Internship:** Internship is a course to develop a professional ability through an appropriate learning. The internship is for 8 weeks.

**Research Project:** Research project is a course involving applications of knowledge in exploring, analysing and solving real life situations/ problems.

Each academic year will be divided into two semesters July to December and January to June.

### **COURSE:**

Each course is made up of following sub components–Lecture/ Tutorial/ Practicum/ Project Work/ Seminar/ Field Work/ Studio Activity/ Practice/ Survey/ Community Engagement and Service

One Mandatory Internship after 2nd Semester/ 4th Semester: All undergraduate students will attend one mandatory internship after 2nd or 4th semester.

### **DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME:**

Undergraduate Certificate in Discipline= 1 Year/ 2 Semester

Undergraduate Diploma in Discipline= 2 Year/ 4 Semester

The duration of Bachelor Degree = 3 year/ 6 Semester

As per NEP 2020 and NIILM University Curriculum Credit Framework, there is Multiple Entry and Exit System (MEES), It allows students to exit a program at any time with a relevant certificate, diploma, or degree, and re-enter the same program or a different program at a later time.

**Note:** Fee structure and program duration mentioned from Page No. 06 to 29 in the prospectus is applicable on UG Certificate/ Diploma/ Degree offered by different schools.

### **HONORS/ HONORS WITH RESEARCH:**

The duration of Honor/ Honors with Research= 4 Year/ 8 Sem

4-year UG Degree (Honours): A four-year UG Honours degree in the major discipline will be awarded to those who complete a 4-year degree programme with 180 credits (184 credits in case of single major) as per NIILM University CCFUGP 2024-25

4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research): Students who secure 75% marks and above in the first six semesters and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year. They should do a research project or dissertation under the guidance of a faculty member of the University. The research project/dissertation will be in the major discipline. The students, who secure 180 credits (184 credits in case of single major), including 12 credits from a research project/dissertation, are awarded UG Degree (Honours with Research).

**Note:** Fee structure mentioned from page number 06 to 29, semester wise is applicable for 7th and 8th semester after 3-year degree program.

### **SUBJECTS AND COURSES OF UG PROGRAMMES:**

The University offers multiple programmes in four categories as per NEP 2020, and NIILM University CCFUGP 2024-25

#### **Category A: Undergraduate Programmes (Multidisciplinary)**

A student of UG Programme (Multidisciplinary), herein after called Category-A, will select three subjects A, B and C in the first year out of the pool of subjects in that discipline offered by the Department/School as Major Subjects. Minor subject is to be offered from the same discipline and will be different from three subjects which are opted as Major Subjects of that discipline. Any subject in a discipline can be a Major or Minor subject for a UG Programme.

### Category B: Undergraduate Programmes (Single Major)

For students who choose to pursue single major after 2nd semester of multidisciplinary Programmes

Students who appeared from category A in 1st and 2nd semester can choose single major subject from semester 3rd onwards and will study as per NIILM University CCFUGP 2024-25.

### Category C: Undergraduate Programmes (Single Major)

For students who choose to pursue single major from 1st semester

Students can choose single major subject from the major subjects' studies at 10+2 level or equivalent examination. A student has to secure a minimum of 50% credits from the major discipline for the 3-year/4-year UG degree to be awarded a single major. For example, in a 3-year UG programme, if the total number of credits to be earned is 136, a student of Physics with a minimum of 68 credits will be awarded a B.Sc. in Physics with a single major. Similarly, in a 4-year UG programme, if the total number of credits to be earned is 184, a student of Physics with a minimum of 92 credits will be awarded a B.Sc. (Hons. /Hon. With Research) in Physics in a 4-year UG programme with single major.

### Category D: Undergraduate Programmes (Interdisciplinary)

A student of UG Programme (Interdisciplinary), herein after called Category-D, will study three core courses of the discipline in each semester as prescribed in the scheme of the concerned programme. Following programmes are offered under this category.

The pool of programs and courses will be provided by the concerned department/ school. Students can choose the desired courses form the pool as per the category.

**Note:** Eligibility for admission to the UG programs will be as per NIILM University CCFUGP 2024-25.

# PG CURRICULUM AND CREDIT FRAMEWORK: HIGHLIGHTS

The University follows the Scheme of Studies as per the recommendations of NEP 2020, adopted from the academic session 2024-25. There is a 2-year programme PG programme with the second year devoted entirely to research for those who have completed the 3-year Bachelor's programme. For students completing a 4-year Bachelor's programme with Honours/Honours with Research, there is a 1-year PG programme. The University offers an integrated 5-year Bachelor's/Master's programme also. Main Features of the PG curriculum framework is:

- Flexibility to move from one discipline of study to another
- Flexibility for students who qualify UG with a major and minor (s) to opt for either major or minor(s) subject or any other subject if they are able to prove their competence in PG programme
- Opportunity for learners to choose the courses of their interest
- Flexibility to switch to alternative modes of learning (offline, ODL, Online learning, and hybrid modes of learning)
- Mobility and flexibility as per the UGC (Establishment and Operation of Academic Bank of Credits in Higher Education) Regulations, 2021, and UGC Guidelines for Multiple Entry and Exit in Academic Programmes offered in Higher Education Institutions.

## Credit Requirement and Eligibility for the PG Programme

- A bachelor's degree with Honours/ Honours with Research with a minimum of 160 credits for a 1-year/2-semester PG programme at level 6.5 on the NHEQF.
- A 3-year/6-semester bachelor's degree with a minimum of 120 credits for a 2-year/4 semester PG programme at level 6.5 on the NHEQF.
- A 4-year Bachelor's degree (e.g. B.E., B.Tech. etc.) with a minimum of 160 credits for a 2-year/4-semester PG programme (e.g. M.E., M. Tech. etc.) at level 7 of NHEQF.
- A student is eligible for a PG programme in a discipline corresponding to either major or minor(s) discipline in UG programme on the basis of entrance exam or other criteria adopted by the University time to time.



# GUIDELINES FOR VARIOUS RESEARCH PROGRAMS

## Ph.D Courses

The degree of Ph.D. may be awarded in the various courses of the different departments:

### Eligibility:

A candidates seeking admission to the course of Ph.D. must fulfil the following relevant academic criteria:

1. A 1-year/ 2-Semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/ 8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/ 4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree program or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale whichever grading system is followed

Or

equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority; established or incorporated under a law in it's home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institutions.

A relaxation of 5% marks or equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ ST/ OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories candidates as per the decision of the commission time to time.

2. Candidates who has completed the M.Phil. programme with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale whichever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit, or assure quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme.

A relaxation of 5% marks or equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ ST/ OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories candidates as per the decision of the commission time to time.

It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure his/her eligibility and fulfilment of such other condition (s) as may be prescribed for admission in the rules and regulations of the University. The admission to Ph.D. course will be in order of merit and subject to availability of seat (s) and expert (s) for guidance/ supervision in the area of research. Before submission of Application Form, the candidate is required to ascertain these facts from the concerned Department/Institute. Merely qualifying the entrance test will not ipso-facto entitle a candidate to get himself/herself enrolled for Ph.D. course in the concerned Department/Institute.

# ADMISSION PROCEDURE IN Ph.D

Research and Development Cell of the university is responsible for the promotions and development of research and managerial support for the operation of research programs, sponsored research, consultancy, and related activities of the university. The Cell facilitates interaction with external agencies, both at national and 2 international levels. The Cell acts as a liaison between the university and funding agency to undertake sponsored projects.

## Duration of Programme

Ph.D. program shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including course work and a maximum of six years, the period shall be counted from the date of issue of provisional enrollment letter.

Every Research Scholar shall submit his/her Thesis within a period of 6 (Six) years from the date of his/her enrolment for Ph.D. Course, but not before 3 (Three) years including course work. If a Research Scholar fails to submit his/her Thesis within a period of 6 (Six) years, will be treated as per UGC Ph.D. regulation issued time to time.

The period of 6 (Six) years for submission of Ph.D. Thesis by a Research Scholar may be extended in exceptional case, for a

Maximum of one year by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendations of the RAC with an extra fee as per relaxation of two years for Ph.D. Course in the maximum duration of 6 (Six) years by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendations of RAC. In addition, the women candidate may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave once in the entire duration of Ph.D. for upto 240 days which shall not be counted in the stipulated period of 6 (Six) years for submission of Ph.D. Thesis, subject to production of maternity certificate from a registered Nursing Home/Govt.

NIILM University changed rules for admission to Ph.D. Course.

Now admission to Ph.D. will be done on the basis of score obtained in UGC NET Exam. According to UGC a total of three categories have been prescribed in this.

Guidelines have been issued for admission to Ph.D. According this, many major changes have been made in the admission process for Ph.D. of NIILM University. Let us know in detail about the changed rule.

## What the new rules issued for admission to Ph.D. in NIILM University?

Recently UGC had issued a guideline for admission to Ph.D. according to Ph.D. According the UGC, NIILM University has kept three categories for admission to Ph.D.

### First Class

JRF pass candidates will be placed in the first category, whose admission in Ph.D. will be on the basis of NET JRF without entrance examination. Only interviews will be organized for this.

### Second Class

NET passed candidates will be placed in the second category. Admission of these candidates will be based on NET Score. Only interviews will be organized for this. NET score will be valid only for one year.

### Third Class

In the third category, those candidates have been kept who have neither passed JRF nor passed NET. Admission of such candidates will be based on the marks obtained in UGC NET paper. The marks obtained in NET will be valid only for one year.

\* Admission in Ph.D. will be as per UGC Ph.D. Regulations issued time to time.



# RDC

## RESEARCH DEGREE COMMITTEE MEMBERS

### The RDC shall consist of:

- a. Dean, Research & Development Cell
- b. Dean, Academic Affairs
- c. An External Expert in the field
- d. Supervisor of the Candidate
- e. Dean/Head of the Department

The above Committee will scrutinize the application and synopsis of the candidate in regard to suitability of the research topic & capability of the student to carry out the research.

The candidate has to submit his/her research proposal to the university and after that a date is given to the candidate for the synopsis presentation. In the RDC meeting the candidate will present the research proposed work under synopsis before the RDC.

On the recommendation of the RDC the candidate will be eligible for registration in Ph.D. Programme. Once the candidate is eligible or registered in the programme he/she has to submit three (Six monthly PR (Annexure-I)) progressive reports to the supervisor.

# ADMISSION RULES & POLICIES

## NATIONAL/INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION POLICY

### PREAMBLE

## INTAKE OF STUDENTS

The Board of Management, on the recommendation of the Academic Council, shall approve the number of seats in various programs of the university at the beginning of each academic session in accordance with the availability of teachers and infrastructure and as per the approval of regulatory bodies.

## RESERVATION OF SEATS

Reservation of seats for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes, Special Backward Classes, Women, and Physically Challenged persons shall be provided as per the policy of the Punjab Government.

For the candidates belonging to Schedule Castes/Schedule Tribes or Other Backward Classes in all the programs of study, the Government rules shall be applicable for determining the eligibility criteria for admission.

# FEE REFUND POLICY

The refund of fees shall be applicable for the following categories:

- As per Government instruction time to time applicable.

## I. TUITION FEE REFUND

1. A request for a fee refund may be submitted through a Student Refund Request Form, which shall be available in the Student Interaction Cell.
2. All supporting documents and evidence together refund must be attached
3. The registration fee and entrance examination fee (wherever applicable) are non-refundable.
4. If the withdrawal application is received on or before the start date for classes, a refund will be issued after deductions as outlined in the table below and if the succeeding seat is not filled by another student, there will be no reimbursement of fees.
5. If the admission is terminated owing to non-payment of the remaining tuition fee by the due date specified in the Provisional Admission Letter, or if the student fails to appear at the University without prior notice, the entire money deposited will be forfeited.
6. Any scholarship awarded will not be considered for calculating fees.
7. Any refund request for payment to third-party bank accounts will be turned down.
8. The students who are expelled or whose names are stricken from the roll list due to non-submission of

documents, failure to register forth with in the given time period, non-payment of dues, or Any other reason is not entitled for refund. Only the security deposit will be reimbursed after paying any outstanding debts.

9. No interest shall be paid on any fees or deposits refunded.
10. In the event of a disagreement, the Director of Finance's decision will be final and binding.
11. The University reserves the right to modify and amend refund policies every year.
12. All disputes arising out of or in connection with this are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of Kaithal.

## 2. HOSTEL FEE REFUND

A hostel room falling vacant due to withdrawal of an allotted if;

1. Only proportional maintenance fee shall be deducted
2. Proportional Mess charges shall be refunded
  - a. If a student has availed hostel facility even for sometime in a calendar month, then mess charges for that calendar month shall additionally be deducted.
  - b. Students who are absent from the hostel for any cause shall not be eligible for any refund. 3. Students who are suspended or expelled from the hostel shall not be eligible for any refund

## 3. TRANSPORTATION CHARGES REFUND

The bus transportation charges will be refunded after proportional deductions.

## INTERNATIONAL ADMISSIONS

As per Government of Haryana/UGC instructions, international students will include the following:

- **Foreign Nationals:** Candidates holding citizenship of any foreign country.
- **Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)/ Overseas Citizen of India (OCI):** A person who or whose any of ancestors was an Indian national and who is presently holding another country's citizenship/ nationality i.e. he/she is holding foreign passport.
- **Non Resident Indians (NRI):** An Indian citizen who is residing outside India and hold an Indian Passport. Only those Non-Resident Indian students who have studied and passed the qualifying examinations from schools or colleges in foreign countries will be included as international students.

# ADMISSION PROCEDURE

International students will be admitted directly against the 10% super numeracy seats, without appearing in the Entrance Test. This will not be applicable to the programs under the statutory bodies. These students shall be admitted to various Degree Programmes under the following categories:

- **Direct Applicants (Full Time Programme):** International students, who wish to join under Self-financed category, are required to submit their application to International Students Division (ISD) of the university. The ISD after document verification, eligibility check from respective departments, interview (online) will communicate to the respective department for further process.
- **Embassy sponsored candidates:** Candidates sponsored by the High Commissions/Embassies of Foreign countries.

International students seeking admission in any one of the aforesaid programmes will have to satisfy the minimum eligibility criteria for admission to the programmes as prescribed by the University.

### OTHER REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- a. All international students will require a 'Student VISA' endorsed to this university for joining

programmes. No other end or segment is acceptable.

- b. Any statutory clearances from MoE, Govt. of India, if required, shall be applicable.

### EQUIVALENCE OF FOREIGN DEGREES FOR ELIGIBILITY QUALIFICATIONS IN CUP

The qualifications required for admission to different programmes will be included in admission brochure. Only those students who have qualified from foreign universities recognized as equivalent by the 'Association of Indian Universities' (AIU) are eligible for admission. When required, a reference will be made to AIU to check the equivalence. Degrees obtained from universities approved by the Department of Education/other statutory bodies of concerned country will also be acceptable.

### REQUIREMENTS COMMON FOR BOTH MASTER AND Ph.D PROGRAMME:

- a. Applicants, who have obtained a valid IELTS or TOEFL score, will get preference.
- b. Those without a valid IELTS or TOEFL score, shall have to pass English Proficiency Test (CEPT) after joining the University. A student deficient in English will be asked to study language courses.
- c. The students with a valid GRE/GMAT

score/grade will get preference.

## STEPWISE PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The procedure for admission to a programme will be as given below. Students may submit the curriculum vitae directly to the ISD.

- Interested International students must read the admission brochure carefully to check the eligibility and visit website.
- International students should submit their curriculum vitae on the prescribed format clearly indicating their academic achievements along with self-signed copies of the documents to the Director, ISD, online/email.
- Photocopies of the following documents are required along with the application on a prescribed format:
  - Proof of date of birth.
  - Certificate and Mark-sheet of qualifying examination. If the Mark-Sheet/Degrees are in a language other than English then a copy of English version is to be submitted too.
  - Copy of passport for foreign citizens or Dual citizenship card for PIO/OCI or NRI status certificate
  - Soft copies of passport size photograph.(JPG format)
  - Two letters of Recommendation
  - Proof of adequate financial support in case of Self-financed category or scholarship/sponsorship.

**Application Time line:** Applications of foreign students for the academic year beginning July/August will be accepted beginning January 1 every year, so that the students able to obtain the VISA and NOC before the start of the academic session.

- The eligibility criteria will be determined by the concerned HoD and equivalency will be verified by AIU/committee of NIILM University. The applicant will be informed via by email, if found eligible.

- The self-sponsored applicant has to make a payment of non-refundable advance amount equivalent to US \$ 100. The application will then be reviewed and if found suitable a 'Provisional Admission Offer Letter' will be issued to enable the student to obtain the VISA.

The 'Provisional Admission Offer Letter' will be submitted to the Indian Embassy of the respective country for obtaining the 'VISA' with a copy to self-sponsored candidate and/or to the concerned sponsoring agency/institution.

The candidate shall report to the university on the notified date for orientation and shall bring all above mentioned documents in original for verification by the ISD. The original certificates will be returned to the students immediately after making an endorsement to this effect.

The students are required to undergo the medical fitness examination at the university and get the medical fitness certificate. Government of India rules for international students entering India on 'Student VISA' for testing for HIV shall apply.

They are also required to produce HIV test report to the Doctor. All international students will be required to obtain medical insurance.

Admission of International students will be confirmed after verification of original certificates, medical fitness test and payment of required fees. Withdrawal of admissions/refund of fees cases will be dealt as per the guidelines of the university. Within a week of arrival in India, students are required to register their names with the police in the 'Foreigner Regional Registration Office (FRRO)' and submit a proof of such registration to the ISD.

The International Students will abide by all the rules of the University and code of conduct as applicable to Indian students undergoing the same course. Anti-social and anti-national activities, misbehavior, violence and unethical activities involving international students will be dealt in accordance with state and central laws that are in force. The university will not take any responsibility for any criminal or non-criminal acts committed inside or outside the campus by the international students.





## ELIGIBILITY UNDER VARIOUS CATEGORIES

- **All India (including Haryana):** A candidate applying from many parts of the country (including Haryana), who complies with the minimum eligibility criteria.
- **Haryana (General):** A candidate, who is a domicile of Haryana and complies with the minimum eligibility criteria. Unfilled seats if any, under this category will be transferred to the all India (including Haryana) category.
- **Haryana (Scheduled Castes):** The candidate must be a domicile of Haryana and belong to a scheduled caste of Haryana as notified by the State Govt. and should comply with the minimum eligibility criteria. Unfilled seats, if any under this category will be transferred to the all India (including Haryana) category.
- **Children/Wards of NRI (Non-resident Indian):** To be eligible for admission under this category, the applicant must fulfill the criteria as prescribed in the Ordinance of NIILM University.
- **Kashmiri Migrants:** One seat in each branch is reserved for Kashmiri Migrants. These seats will be supernumerary and will be filled on the basis of inter-se-merit, on the basis of marks of qualifying examination and subject to the candidate complying with the minimum eligibility criteria. They will be required to submit the original certificate of migration duly signed by the competent authority.
- **Unfilled Seats:** The unfilled seat(s), if any, under Haryana General and/or NRI category (excluding Kashmiri Migrants) will be transferred to the all India category including Haryana. A candidate, who applies under a reserved category, will be considered first under the all India Category. Only in case, he/she does not get a seat, he/she will be considered under the reserved category subject to the availability of a seat and as per his/her merit.

## SCHOLARSHIP

The Students admitted under direct applicant category are eligible to get merit scholarship/earn-while-learn assistantship as per the prevailing norms.

### SAFETY AND SECURITY

The university provides a range of safety and security services to ensure that the students are able to have a safe time while studying on campus. The following services and initiatives are available to students:

1. Security staff is available 24x7 in the campus.
2. It is important that all incidents and crimes be reported quickly to enable the university to take action. Reported incidents are formally recorded and investigated, and any information is treated with the strictest confidence.

### INTERNATIONAL STUDENT MENTORING PROGRAM

The International Students Division (ISD) is single point of contact for the international students for their convenience and quick access. ISD assists international students in overcoming life changing experiences of arriving alone in another country and other cultural/academic challenges. The students shall have a mentor to get academic and personal guidance. Peer mentoring is also provided to all international students.

# ATTENDANCE RULES

As regular attendance is an important element of education, no leave of absence will be granted except on a serious reason (especially on, medical ground). University will have an attendance committee comprising at least three senior teaching staffs Dean or Head of a particular department.

1. Minimum 75% attendance is must for the students to fill the university Examination form and to appear in End (final) Semester.
2. Students will have to complete 75% attendance clauses that will be considered as an average of all lectures, practical and tutorials. However, it will be mandatory for students to maintain a minimum of 50 per cent attendance in every subject.
3. Uncertified absence for more than 10 class days renders the student liable to be suspended/terminated from the rolls and usual admission fee will be charged if he/she is readmitted.

4. No student who comes late shall be allowed to enter in class without the permission of HOD. Fulfillment of minimum attendance criteria and satisfactorily clearance of all academic subjects are the sole responsibilities of individual student.
5. If a student has a genuine problem due to which her/his attendance has suffered, the committee will verify the reason. After the approval of the VC, the student will be allowed to appear for the exam.
6. 10% of total absentia of students due to illness may be considered by the admission committee if the student provides bonafide reasons with supporting documents. Example - If you are absent for 20 days due to illness then present of only 2 Days will be considered.
7. Attendance is given 5 marks weightage in Internal Assessment Marks for regularity in attending lectures and tutorial, and the credit for regularity in each paper, based on attendance, as per NEP-2020.

# EXAMINATION RULES

1. It is compulsory to bring your Admit card & Identity Card with you.
2. Reach the examination Center at least half an hour before the commencement of the examination; and occupy the seat that bears your Enrollment Number.
3. DO NOT take any kind of ready reckoner to the examination hall.
4. Write your Registration Number, as given in the Admit Card, on the answer sheet & on the question paper also.
5. During the examination, follow the instructions of the invigilator strictly.
6. Hand over your answer sheet to the invigilator before you leave the Examination Hall.
7. Personal belongings like Bags, Purses, and Luggage etc. are not allowed inside the Examination Hall. These items should be kept outside the room.
8. Candidates are requested to cooperate to maintain perfect exam environment; any misbehaviour will be treated as violation of rules and the candidate will be expelled from the exam.
9. In case of non receipt or loss of the ADMIT CARD, a duplicate admit card will be issued at the Examination center.
10. Candidates must keep perfect silence and not allowed to use any gadget during the examination.

The University will summarily punish or reprimand the guilty student, either by itself or by following procedures, administrative or otherwise, by constituting a special Enquiry Committee and put forth its findings or recommendations before the competent authority to take a decision. Students are encouraged to report any ragging act witnessed or experienced by them to the university administrators, faculty, Anti-Ragging Cell and Grievance Redressal Cell or any other staff member with whom the student may feel comfortable. The University ensures the confidentiality of such a disclosure by the student.

# LEGAL LITERACY CELL

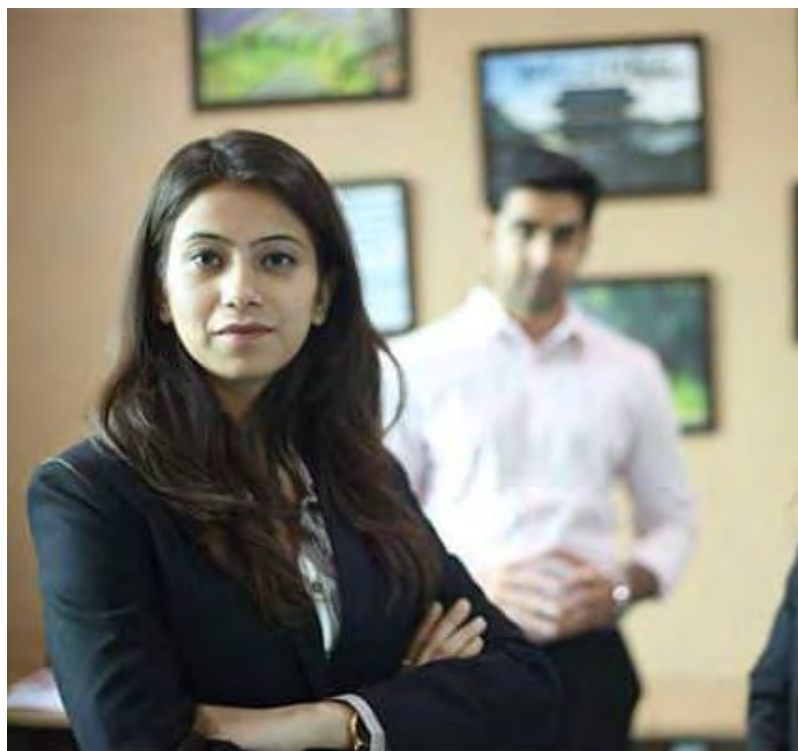

# LIBRARY



The library serves as a backbone to all academic activities on the campus. Our library House has a collection of 34,000 books including texts and reference materials, journals, magazines, audio-videos, CDROMS and research reports which have been carefully selected from a number of national and international professional institutions. All students have direct access to library resources not only of their own faculty but also of other faculty to promote interdisciplinary interaction. The library provides a quiet study space for students on campus; it may also provide group study space, such as meeting rooms. The library provides a "gateway" for students, faculty members and researchers to access various resources, both print/physical and digital. The university's library has subscribed to electronic journals databases, providing research and scholarly writing software, and usually provides computer workstations or computer labs for students to access journals, library search databases and portals, institutional electronic resources, internet access, and course- or task-related software (i.e. word processing and spreadsheet software). They are increasingly acting as an electronic repository for institutional scholarly research and academic knowledge, such as the collection of digital copies of students' theses and dissertations.

Students are advised to refer to the same for clarification. No other form of communication other than those mentioned, whether written or verbal is there between the University and the students.
4. Except for the refundable security, none of the components of the fees once paid is refundable under any circumstances.
5. NIILM University reserves its right to revise its fee structure as and when recommended by the management,
6. The University reserves the right to cancel the admission of any candidate under any of the following circumstances,
  - a) If the fess is not deposited by the stipulated date.
  - b) If the candidates does not join the particular programme by the stipulated date even though the Fee has been deposited.
  - c) If the candidates fails to furnish the proof of the minimum eligible qualification required for admission into the program/course within the stipulated time frame. d) If he/she indulge in Ragging Activities.
7. A candidate found indulging in drug/alcohol abuse, violence or improper behaviour and does not abide by the rules and regulation as are relevant from time to time, he/she will be rusticated.
