

KAITHAL

(Ancient Kapisthal – The Sacred Land of Hanuman)

According to Purana, **LORD HANUMAN** was also born in **KAITHAL**. The great 'Tilla of Anjani' is also situated here which is named after his mother Anjani. The local people assassinated Razia Begum, the daughter of Eltutmus alongwith her husband on October 13, 1240. The Tomb of Rajia Begam is still found here.

Kaithal was part of the Karnla District at the time of Haryana State formation. Later Kaithal became the part of the Kurukshetra District. On November 01, 1989, it became the headquarter of the Kaithal District of Haryana. Kaithal has only three and half hours drive from the National Capital.

It is located near the Bidkian Lake, and was an important town during Akbar's rule. The town is said to have been founded by Yudhishtira in celebration of the Pandavas' victory in the Mahabharata. It was first known as Kapisthala, or Abode of Monkeys, and is the birth place of the monkeys' God 'Hanuman'. A temple in memory of Hanuman's mother 'Anjana', is built here.

Kaithal has many colleges and schools which are imparting world class

education to the students of Kaithal District area. The NIILM Education Trust has established the NIILM University in Kaithal. This is a major landmark in the education sector of the Kaithal District. The international feel, well developed infrastructure and the quality of education, all contribute to the academic excellence of the University. It is believed that in the coming years the University will contribute in a big way to the growth and development of not only Kaithal, but the entire state. At present, Kaithal is a flourishing town known for its cotton and rice plantation. All modern facilities and amenities are available in the city. Kaithal holds a distinguished place in medieval Indian history as the site associated with the final chapter of the legendary ruler Razia Sultan, the first and only woman to rule the Delhi Sultanate. Historical accounts connect this region with the fierce conflict between Razia Sultan and the rebel forces that challenged her authority. Her memory continues to live on through the tomb and historical landmarks that attract visitors and history enthusiasts alike. During the reign of Emperor Akbar, Kaithal gained further prominence with the development of a fortified settlement that strengthened its strategic importance. Following the Third Battle of Panipat (1761), the region came under the leadership of Bhai Desu Singh, a prominent Sikh chief. His historic residence, overlooking the tranquil lake, remains an enduring symbol of Kaithal's rich cultural and political heritage. Today, these monuments, forts, and heritage sites stand as timeless reminders of the city's remarkable journey through centuries of courage, leadership, and transformation.
