



8. That in case any dispute arises between the parties, the M.O.U. shall come to an end with mutual consent and both the parties shall be entitled to share all information each other. So the enrolled candidates should not suffer.

Scope of the Agreement:

The purpose of the agreement is to implement vocational skill development training programs in coordination with industries.

1. Executing an MoU for implementation of the different types of vocational training programs as per the terms of the scheme's guidelines and further communications by the Govt. of India and concerned departments.
2. Delivery of the training program will be by the Project Execution Partner (Perfect E learning)

3. Monitoring of programs & ensuring quality in training delivery.
4. Collection of fee and service charges from the concerned company.
5. Identification / Association with industries for said projects.

Term of Agreement:

This agreement will be valid for 3+1 years and applicable for renewal on the basis of performance.

Termination:




